Juliet Christina was a girl from Blue Bell, Pennsylvania who passed away after a long battle with Mitochondrial Disease in September, 2020. Juliet loved having books read to her by friends and family, as they were a way for people to bond with her, and gave her a sense of community and belonging. As we grew older, we continued to find ways to connect with Juliet, spending birthdays together, meeting up to do arts and crafts, hanging out with her dogs, and just enjoying spending time together. We want to spread everything that Team Jules represents; hope, strength, kindness, positivity, and so much more.

In Juliet's 16 years of life, she was hospitalized too many times! When children are in-patient for more than a day or two, the hospital can become very dull. Luckily, hospitals such as Nemours have Child Life Centers, which are lifesavers for the whole family. The "Juliet's Place" cart at Nemours is a mobile cart that Child Life is able to bring into patient rooms. The cart has many books (Juliet's favorite way to pass time) but also simple crafts and family games for all ages. Anything purchased will be delivered by us directly to Nemours/Dupont's Child Life Office for the holidays.
